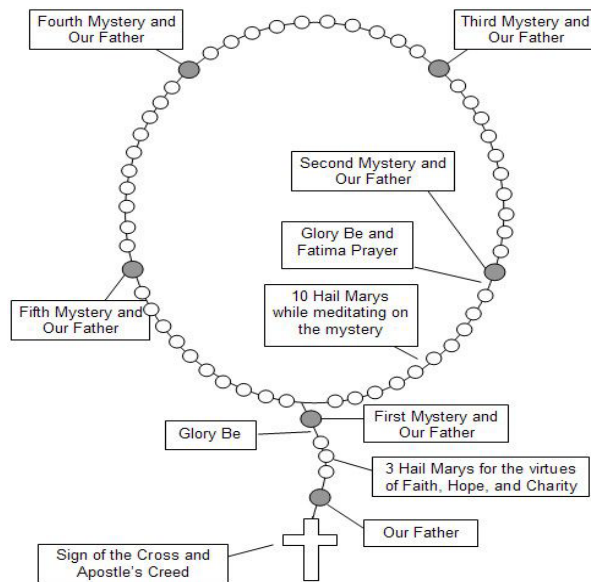


## October Devotion: The Holy Rosary

1. The Rosary starts with the Sign of the Cross followed by saying the “Apostle’s Creed”.
2. Say the “Our Father”
3. Say three “Hail Marys”
4. Say the “Glory be to the Father”.
5. Announce the **First Mystery**; then say the “Our Father”.
6. Say ten “Hail Marys” while meditating on the Mystery.
7. Say the “Glory be to the Father”.
8. After each decade say the “**Fatima Prayer**” requested by the Blessed Virgin Mary.
9. Announce the **Second Mystery**; then say the “Our Father”. Repeat steps 6,7 8 and continue with the Third, Fourth and Fifth Mysteries in the same manner.
10. After completing the five decades, say the “**Hail, Holy Queen**” and make the Sign of the Cross.
